

OVERVIEW

This program prepares internationally educated nurses (IENs) for a career as a **Registered Nurse (RN)** or **Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN)** in Canada. You will learn about interpersonal communication, medical terminology in the Canadian health care setting, and gain a minimum of 335 hours of hands-on experience through clinical placements, practicums and co-op work experiences which will help you integrate seamlessly in the Canadian workplace.

The program prepares you to begin the regulatory process with the BC College of Nursing Professionals (BCCNP) to meet regulatory requirements for licensure and registration as an LPN or RN after program completion.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Pre-requisites:

- Bachelor degree in Nursing
 (Diploma in nursing may be considered if work experience is 4+ years of employment as a nurse)
- Current registration as an RN from your country of origin or last country where majority of work experience is completed
- Minimum 2 years full-time work (30hrs/week), or the parttime equivalent, as a Registered Nurse within last 10 years.
 900 hours of that work must be within the last 5 years.
- International students must additionally provide a police certificate from your country of origin
- It is strongly recommended that applicants have 3120+ hours of paid work experience as a nurse to assist with the process of immigration
- To meet practicum placement requirements, we highly recommend students bring copies of all immunization records from their home country.
