Graduation Requirements

In order to be eligible for graduation from a program, students much have:

- 1. Successfully completed and passed all courses in your program, including all practice education experiences.
- 2. Successfully completed all program prerequisites, as required for your program.
- 3. Successfully completed all contractor workshops, as required for your program.
- 4. Met all program attendance requirements.
- 5. Current good financial standing with the College.
- 6. Exhibited behaviours consistent with requirements for employment in a healthcare, business, and/or human services setting.
- 7. Completed at least 50% of your studies at Stenberg College (if course challenge credits have been granted).

If any of the above criteria are not met, you will not be eligible to receive your certificate/diploma, official transcript, and will not be invited to the graduation ceremony for your program.

Graduation with Academic Distinction: Stenberg College graduates who achieved an overall academic average of 90% or above in their program will receive the designation of "Academic Distinction". If you qualify for this designation, it will be indicated on your transcript. Please note that this designation will not be indicated on certificates/diplomas.
